

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-121

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COCOA, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR FINANCE DIRECTOR TO SIGN ANY CONTRACTS AND AMENDMENTS FROM THE FLORIDA DIVISION OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT RELATED TO TROPICAL STORM NICOLE REIMBURSEMENT; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS, SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Cocoa has potential impacts by Tropical Storm Nicole during the time period of November 9, 2022 through November 11, 2022; and

WHEREAS, Governor Ron DeSantis issued Executive Order 22-253, declaring a state of emergency for several counties within the State of Florida in response to Subtropical Nicole, which was later upgraded to a Tropical Storm on November 8, 2022.

WHEREAS, Brevard County is listed as one of the counties impacted by Tropical Storm Nicole that is eligible for reimbursement of costs incurred through preparation for Tropical Storm Nicole landfall and damages from Tropical Storm Nicole; and

WHEREAS, various agreements and forms will be required to be signed by an authorized person representing the City of Cocoa, Florida: and

WHEREAS, the Florida Division of Emergency Management will be the contracting agency with the responsibility to issue payments for reimbursement for Tropical Storm related costs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COCOA, as follows:

SECTION 1. The City Council of the City of Cocoa hereby authorizes the City Manager or the Finance Director to execute all contracts and modifications from the Florida Division of Emergency Management for Tropical Storm Nicole related costs.


SECTION 2. Staff will present the final approved amount of the reimbursed costs upon completion of the contract.

SECTION 3. Repeal of Prior Inconsistent Resolutions. All prior resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of that conflict.

SECTION 4. Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, word, or portion of this resolution is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion hereto.

SECTION 5. Effective Date. This resolution shall become effective at 8:00 a.m. on November 9, 2022 following adoption by the City Council of the City of Cocoa, Florida.
